Gifted Gifts

Trade Tricks

- Show up consistently; presence outlasts any single conversation.
- Let them struggle a little — confidence is earned, not given.
- Tell them what you see in them; words become their inner voice.

CYNDEE'S CURE

When a child shuts down, don't push harder — get quieter. Sit beside them, lower your voice, and wait. Calm is contagious, and a regulated adult is the fastest way to a regulated kid.

BRETT'S BEST

Believe in them out loud and on repeat. Kids rise to the version of themselves they hear you describe. Be the voice in their head that says they can.
